The local host can offer suggestions to help you make the best use of your time. You may want to visit Montmartre and enjoy the artists at work in the Place du Tertre or simply stroll the Champs-Élysées.

Your Parisian adventure begins with a guided drive up the grand boulevard, Champs-Élysées, to the Arc de Triomphe, known as *Etoile* to the locals. You’ll continue the panoramic tour, stopping at Les Invalides for a photo, then proceeding to the Luxembourg Gardens and enjoying a brief walk (weather permitting). The tour concludes with a photo stop at the Eiffel Tower. You may choose to take a ride to the top of the tower for an unparalleled view of the city.

It will be time for lunch when you can plan your afternoon adventure. You’ll be free to explore the city on your own. You may want to visit one of the city’s more than 50 museums, including the Louvre and Musée d’Orsay, with their astounding world-famous collections. The Orangerie Museum in the Tuileries Gardens is not far away, where you can view the original Monet painting of *Les Nymphéas (The Water-lilies)*. Please check with your local host for museum hours.

Day 3

Paris

Spend the day as you wish visiting sights you’ve missed such as Notre Dame Cathedral, France’s Gothic masterpiece, and nearby Sainte-Chapelle, which house the world’s most treasured stained-glass windows. Both are located on the Île de la Cité (the heart of the city). Take time to relax with a ride on a *bateaux mouche*, one of the boats that offer scenic rides on the Seine.
